Groups – Ticket regulations

Welcome to the Davos Klosters Mountains

We warmly welcome groups to the Davos Klosters Mountains. With five winter sports areas and 250 kilometers of slopes and over 80 different runs, the Davos Klosters Mountains are one of the largest snow sports areas in the Alps.

Special group rates apply to groups of at least 15 persons traveling together, whereby children and young people are counted as whole persons. An association or club is recognized as a group. The period of validity of the tickets must either begin on the same day of validity or end on the same day of validity.

Order handling

Tickets are ordered by mail at the selected cashier desk no later than two days in advance. In the case of mixed groups, a list of names, including date of birth for young people and children, must be sent with the order. Tickets are issued in advance so that the group members can get to the ski area as quickly as possible.

Pick-up of the tickets

The leader/organizer of the group purchases all tickets together. Individual delivery is not possible. Tickets will be handed out only at the agreed cash desk. All ski passes are personal and non-transferable. Group leaders are responsible for ensuring that all tickets are distributed in an age-appropriate manner. Random ticket checks will be made at the ski areas.

Validity range

The regional ski passes are valid on all lifts of the Parsenn, Gotschna, Jakobshorn, Rinerhorn, Pischa and Madrisa as well as on the valley ski lifts in Davos and Klosters (without Schatzalp). The valley ski lift Selfranga accepts our regional ski passes only from a 3-day ski pass. Please note the operating times of the individual ski areas.

Key cards

Group tickets are issued on KeyTickets (free paper tickets). The KeyTicket must be worn on the left side of the body in order to be recognized by the system.

Loss of tickets

The group leaders receive a receipt with the ticket numbers when they pick-up the tickets. In order to block the old ticket and issue a new one in case of loss of a ticket, we need the number of the lost ticket. We therefore recommend to note the names with the numbers on the receipt when giving it to the group members or the persons take a photo of their personal ski pass with the cell phone right away.

Rates for groups

The discount level is based on the total group size, even if the group consists of different age categories.

Adults are counted from 18. birthday, teenager 13 - 17 years old, children 6 - 12 years old.
